What is the All American Rally ?

Your rally fees include a Pig Roast dinner and a breakfast. A schedule of events and times will be given to you when you check-in.

Bring items for the \$.10 auction (both kids and adults), and the cake roulette (both kids and adults). Since we have a lot of new members here is an explanation for these events. Keep in mind that the proceeds go towards the Rally.

\$.10 auction:

People donate things like they would for a garage sale. Raffle Tickets are sold for \$.10 and half the ticket is placed in a bag in front of the item you would like to win. If your lucky ticket is drawn, you win that item. If the item before the one you win has no tickets for that item, you win that item too.

Cake Roulette:

There is a board that you place a quarter on that has a color and a number. If the roulette wheel lands on the space where you put your quarter, you win the item. It could be a home baked item (which at one time everything was homemade), packaged cupcakes, cookies, a full cake, a pie, or a jar of nuts. You get the idea. 
