How to Ensure You Always Get Your Newsletter via Email

Occasionally, your newsletter may get sent to your email spam folder.

Here are two tips that work with just about any email program to prevent this from happening.

First, add the ttcmnews@usa.com email address to your contacts or address book. This tells your email program that you care about this particular sender's emails.

Second, if your newsletter email still ends up in spam, go into your email spam folder, select the TTCM newsletter message, and click "Not Spam", "Remove From Spam", or whatever similarly labeled button your program uses. Your email program will learn your preferences as you do this.

However, it's generally better to add the sender to your contacts. This is a clearer signal to your email program that you want to see emails from TTCM.


