In thinking about this issue is it intended as a benefit so that some of the past presidents and life members could live at the camp grounds for the summer without being charged for camping, or was it meant for just week ends? Many of the past presidents and life members spent their whole life building something we all enjoy today. The past presidents and life members have had this benefit for many years. Some received it for many years of service and some for a one term of service. It is up to you the membership to decide in good conscience whether or not you think this benefit should change.

Results of Survey

The Results for the survey sent out by the By-Law committee last year.

We the By-Law committee decided to run a survey on the free camping issue. We were going to ask for postage money at the May meeting. We then decided to just put the survey in the Newsletter and save a lot of postage. We had around 250 units at the time of the mailing which would be about 500 members. We received 50 surveys back with 92 members responding. This would equal about 20%.

ALL AMERICAN RALLY INFORMATION

I have had a few members questioning the increased rally fee for this All American Rally. Last year's \$25 rally fee was due to the use of an old form that was sent to the editor. The board had set the fee at \$35 a few years ago for the All American Rally. So, what in reality may seem like a large increase is truly only \$5. Hope this helps those of you who may have thought that this was a large increase to \$40 this year. I want to make sure you understand why we wanted to increase the rally fee.

For your rally fee you will receive:

- **7 meals (which are diabetic friendly & for the most part children friendly)**
- **a goodie bag valued at \$10.00 or more**
- **2 VERY special events**
- **children activities**
- **normal All American Rally events**

The following is information you will need for the weekend:

1. At this time all the games and events have been filled by chapters stepping forward (and we didn't have to twist any arms!), Thank You chapters!! Please keep in mind that we do need a member from each chapter to help at each meal. Sign-up sheets will be posted in the Rec Hall.
2. All units that are on the grounds 2 weeks before the rally may need to move so our parking chairperson (Judy Collins) can park the units by chapter. Thank you! So if you plan on coming that early a call to Judy might save you having to hitch back up.
3. ALL units on the grounds for the rally weekend must pay a rally fee even if they choose not to participate in the activities.
4. Your rally registration chairperson is begging, on her hands and knees, that everyone registers **early**, this is being asked because there are many items that are being made and we want everyone to have them. Keep in mind that we will offer refunds if you give us a 3-day notice prior to the weekend—we also would refund any emergency that came up at the last minute.
5. We need every person to bring a can of non-cream style vegetables, if you arrive prior to Friday night please bring your cans to the kitchen.
6. Cake roulette items: Each chapter is to bring 2 home-made items (non-cream) for adults and 1 home-made or purchased item for children.
7. This year tank prizes will be for the adults only so we need each chapter to bring 4 items valued between 7 and 10 dollars—new items only please.
8. Brown bag items: Put any family friendly item in a brown bag and seal it. Please bring those items to the Rec. Hall before 8pm Friday night.

TTCM Executive Board Meeting
Hesperia Saturday May 4th 2013 at 10.00 am

Meeting called to order by president Roger Vogel with the TTCM secretary present to conduct meeting.

Invocation given by Sherry Murrie

Roll Call: BL Judith Collins, DD Bruce Alm, DW Darren Westphal, GA Steve McNeil, GV Scott Bouwman, HC Harriet Conklin (proxy) , HW Elizabeth VerPlank, MAL Chuck Dickinson, RO Cheryl Dennis, Sr.A Dick Hamlin, VP Daryl Westphal, Treas. Brenda Hilderbrandt, Sec. Leo Fitzpatrick, Pres. Roger Vogel All above present. Chapters not represented: RR, HH, DT.

Secretary correspondence: A letter from Darlene Owens of River Raisen stating her thoughts on the agenda for the Executive meeting in Hesperia was read.

Secretary report: A correction to the membership meeting September 2, 2012 stating we had retained a law firm. Correction we do not have a law firm on retainer. President Vogel asked for a motion to approve the membership meeting minutes of September 2nd as printed in the newsletter subject to the correction made. A motion by Steve McNeal we accept the minutes as corrected, 2nd. By Darren Westphal. Motion carried.

Treasures report: Both campgrounds will open with \$3000.00 as operating funds. Will give more information later in this meeting.

Campground reports: Bellevue needs to get chairs for the upper shelter (18). An emergency repair for the ceiling on the kitchen side was done at a cost of \$1100.00. No action from the board was needed because this had to be done. The cost was for drywall, paint, tape and some labor, most of the installation was done by members. There were no leaks from the roof that caused this problem just age. Also the lights will be turned sideways to improve lighting more area. A request that we purchase (2) ceiling vents to put above the stove from Menards at a cost to not exceed \$600.00. A motion by Elizabeth VerPlank that we purchase the vents 2nd. By Bruce Alm discussion was heard and the motion approved. Please read your news letter concerning planning meetings of both campgrounds.

Hesperia Report: Ray Hilderbrandt (proxy) gave a report on conditions that need to be addressed 1. Leak at the dump station unable to get to it because of the size of the manhole. A bid from Mansfield of \$242.20 plus tax for the culvert was received this does not include installation. There is \$434.77 left in the water fund and they can use it for this repair and anything that is an emergency to keep the campground running in a safe

manner. Two of the outhouses need to be updated at cost of \$500.00. A motion by Steve McNeal that we update the two outhouses 2nd. By Elizabeth VerPlank Discussion, Motion passed. Handicap portable will be moved closer to the recreation building. A new sign for the front of the campground was presented to purchase. An estimate of \$375.00 for a sign of 8 foot by 27 and one half feet out of metal with 8 inch letters. Much discussion on the signs size and if permits are needed. It would be lighted with solar power. Brenda Hilderbrandt said there is \$500.00 available from the improvement fund. There is no need to make a motion to approve this money. There is a need for one inch steel pipe for fire pits, and anything that you want to donate for the garage sale. A pop corn popper is available to the members for their use but you must clean it after. The garage sale and open house will be the same dates 21 and 22 of June.

MAL report: Chuck Dickinson said he had nothing to report.

Standing Committee reports: Melissa Murrie gave a report on the All American rally and thanked Blossomland for helping be co-chapters. The reservation forms will be in the upcoming news letter with cost of the rally. She said the cost of the registration fee should be raised to \$40.00 which will include 7 meals excluding the meal presented by Double Dozen, a motion to raise the registration fee to \$40.00 by Judith Collins and 2nd. By Scott Bouwnman. Discussion on it. Motion passed. Also requested seed money of \$3500.00 with the intent of paying back. A motion to raise the seed money to \$3500.00 with the intent of paying back by Darren Westphal and 2nd by Scott Bouwman, Motion defeated 8 to 7.

Requested \$2500.00 for seed money for the All American rally: A motion to give seed money of \$2500.00 with the intent of paying back by Judith Collins and 2nd by Darren Westphal. Discussion on the motion. Motion passed 9 to 6.

Melissa also said registration fee would be returned if given 72 hours notice, banner quilts must be returned in by July 1st or sooner. Please read upcoming newsletter for information on the All American.

Treasure report: Brenda said that the annual audit of TTCM was done. Members: Barb Annis, Steve McNeal helped with the audit all books are up to date and funds accountable for. A motion that they be accepted as printed by Chuck Dickinson and 2nd by Steve McNeal discussion none motion passed.

Old Business: Discussed the brick fund with vice president Daryl Westphal on orders and site location. At the present time Bellevue has sold 20 and Hesperia 5.

Recreation Hall of Fame Brick fund is at \$323.50 of the \$500.00 needed. It was suggested that we sell tickets and have fund raiser to get the additional funds.

A motion by Harold Hemry made at a previous meeting, to send new officers to tax school for nonprofit clubs at Lansing, needs to be addressed. Brenda said that with the new accounting firm we do not need the schooling. Our nonprofit status has changed.

Hemry was not present to respond. A motion was made not to send the officers to the school by Steve McNeal and 2nd by Judith Collins. Motion approved.

Campground Co-Directors: There was much discussion on the need to have one. The director has to leave for certain matters and someone with authority has to deal with the duties of the campground. The Co Director for Bellevue is Darrell Kauffman and the Hesperia Co Director is Edna McCastle. A discussion on the name to be a co director or assistant director. Assistant director was chosen and a motion to that was made by Darren Westphal and 2nd by Judith Collins Motion approved.

New Business

Procedures for property tenders was addressed that they must check current roster to see if members dues are paid for the current year.

Membership enrollment will remain the same \$50.00 and TTCM dues the same \$30.00.

By-Law committee report: Carolyn Fitzpatrick RO, Chuck Dickinson MAL, Gayla Alm DD, Jon Baker GA were on the by-law committee. At the request of members at the All American Membership meeting in 2012, It was suggested that some by-law changes need to be made. A survey was conducted thru the newsletter asking members for their input. There were 92 members that responded with the following: Current officers (Pres. VP, Treas., Sec.) with these Numbers: free 53 ½ price 24 full price 15

Past Pres. And Life members: Free 2 ½ price 21 Full Price 67

Due to this response we have put these changes into the new by-laws with a vote at the general membership meeting in the fall. There was a lot of discussion about the free camping issue. VerPlank, Conklin, and Hamlin against it, and taking away what was given to them in the past. Cheryl Dennis remarked that things do change and several others remarked that this was a financial issue due to the loss of membership, and increase in prices of everything. Vice President Westphal stated that this was what the membership wanted and this is what we need to do. President Vogel said that we asked the membership what they wanted, and this is there response. He said we must vote to take it to the membership.

Steve McNeal made the motion to take the by-law changes to the members at the next membership meeting and 2nd, by Judith Collins. The following is the record of the vote: BL Judith Collins Yes, DD Bruce Alm Yes, DT Absent, Dw Darren Westphal Yes, GA Steve McNeal Yes, GV Scott Bouwman Yes, HC Harriet Conklin No, HH Absent, HW Liz VerPlank No, MAL Chuck Dickinson Yes, RO Cheryl Dennis Yes, RR Absent, Sen Advisor Abstain, VP Daryl Westphal Yes, Treas, Brenda Hilderbrandt Yes, Sec. Leo Fitzpatrick Yes, Hisperia Dir. Ray Hilderbrandt proxy Yes, Bellevue Dir. Yes, a total of 12 Yes 2 No 1 abstained Motion passed.

The by-law committee will put all changes in the news letter for the membership to read.

Insurance for both campgrounds: The VP Daryl, Treas. Brenda and the Sec. Leo met with an insurance representative from Ohio. This is the same company we deal with Auto Owners but this representative deals with campgrounds. He can offer a 14% savings on our current policy with better coverage. Some of the things he said we lack in is insurance for members who go buy things for the campgrounds. Lawyers are just waiting to tackle businesses like ours. That 14% savings which could amount to \$500 if we join a local chamber of commerce. This company would also cover members who move trailers. Daryl looked into the closest one to us who offer discounts and Charlotte was accepted. The cost of this membership is \$60.00 which would save us \$500. No action on buying this policy until the current one runs out. Steve McNeal made a motion we go with the new company when this policy runs out. 2nd. By Elizabeth VerPlank Motion approved.

Web site cost us \$168.00 a year to maintain Dan Gatchell runs it.

A buyer contacted Bellevue on timber cutting. Members told them no.

Treasure Hilderbrant said we will no longer use Sams Club membership. There was not enough buying at that store. We have tax free numbers for Menards, Lowes, Staples and Gordon Foods.

A discussion on group rates giving discounts to large groups. No action on this subject.

It was brought up by Brenda Hilderbrandt to put the adult teen advisor on the Executive Board with a vote. Discussion was held and President Vogel said he would talk to the present advisor and get back with the committee and members. This will be discussed at the by-law meeting in the fall.

A motion to adjourn by Steve McNeal and 2nd. By Elizabeth VerPlank Motion carried.

**ADDITIONS AND / OR CORRECTIONS TO THE BY-LAWS
FIRST DRAFT**

Article IV Membership:

C. PAST PRESIDENTS—Delete the words and camping fees waived.

Past Presidents in gratitude for their service shall have their TTCM annual membership dues waived.

D. Life Member: Change in language: and delete free use of all club campgrounds.

A Life Member shall be a retiring officer of the executive Committee, other than the President and his / her surviving spouse, who has served 12 or more consecutive years on the Executive Committee. As a tribute from the club will have their annual membership dues waived.

Move F and G under Recreational Vehicle Ownership:

Delete H: Temporary Membership

F. Recreational Vehicle Ownership: In the event that a member or couple, no longer own an RV due to finances, age, or illness, may continue their membership without provision of a recreational vehicle ownership in Article IV sub-paragraph A.

G. Surviving Spouse: A spouse of a surviving member may continue their membership without regards to the provision of recreational vehicle ownership in article IV sub-paragraph A.

H. Disabled Member: A disabled member or couple may continue their membership without regards to the provision of recreational ownership in article IV sub-paragraph A.

Article V dues and fees:

B. Delete: Life Members- Nil

D. Add from the All American Rally to December 31st.

D. Dues are payable from the All American Rally to December 31st of each calendar year for which membership shall be automatically suspended for non-payment of dues [NPD] and shall forfeit all rights and privileges of membership.

E. Change January 31st to January 1st.

E: Members whose dues are remitted and received after January 1st shall not be reinstated unless such sum of money received as dues shall be accompanied by an additional sum of money designated as a reinstatement fee, the amount of which shall be established by the Board of Directors. Decals/ numbers are not part of the reinstatement fee.

Article VI: Government

C. Addition of the Teen Adult Advisor to the Board of Directors with a vote. This needs to be discussed.

Article X Duties of officers, Trustees, and others

C. Add to Secretary. Send a monthly report of all new and reinstated members to the treasure and newsletter editor.

D. Delete: shall make a monthly report of all new /reinstated members and issue same.

E .Member-at-large: Add a new paragraph for #3 about Write-Ins, then change numbers for 3-4-5-6

Add: 3. A member for two [2] years in good standing may submit their name and which office they desirous to run for Only as a write-in candidate.

Change numbers from 3-4 and 4-5 and 5-6.

Campground Director/Trustee :

F. Change on a monthly basis to weekly basis.

Shall provide a detailed report of all moneys received and disbursed on a weekly basis.

1. Delete the scheduled planning committee meetings and quorum of 2/3 and add new language.

1. All major improvements to the campgrounds shall have campground planning committee approval and majority approval of the Board of Directors prior to funds being committed disbursed. The Campground Director will call for and set up all planning committee meetings when needed. All members need to be notified thirty {30} days in advance of the scheduled meeting via the newsletter.

Article XIII Conduct of Members :

B. Delete: There will be no alcohol beverages allowed in any of the TTCM buildings.

Article XIV Forming Chapters : Delete: step 4.

4. The chapter must be incorporated in the State of Michigan, or the state in which it was formed and must annually keep on file with the TTCM Secretary a copy of their current filing document.

Move the other numbers up 4 – 5- 6-7

1. All members of the proposed chapter must be TTCM members in good standing.
2. Minimum necessary officers shall consist of: President, Vice-President, and Secretary/Treasurer. The new chapter must have at least five {5} units.
3. By-Laws of the club shall be the governing document however; a chapter may adopt additional by-laws for their chapters operation and guidance.
4. Admission of the new chapter to TTCM is by majority vote of the Executive Committee.
5. If at any time a chapter disbands, the remaining property and assets shall revert to TTCM.
6. The chapter shall have representation on the Board of Directors as herein specified.
7. The chapter shall have representation on the Board of Directors as herein specified.
