For those who have never used Zoom for a meeting you can attend this meeting on your personal computer, tablet, or cell phone.

You **do not need** the Zoom app to attend this meeting. However, be aware that Zoom will try everything in their power to get you to download their app. Ignore their download requests.

- Step 1) Copy or type the above URL address into your web browser and hit enter.
- Step 2) Zoom will tell you open the Zoom App, or, download the Zoom App. Again, ignore this.
- Step 3) The very last sentence on the page will say:

"Having issues with the Zoom Workplace app? Join from your browser"

- Step 4) Click on "Join from your browser". This should take you to the meeting login screen.
- Step 5) Provide login info and you will be taken to the meeting.

Note: I had to repeat step 4 & 5 several times during a test run. As with any web based meeting they never seem to work the same way twice. Step 4 & 5 screens should change and update within 20 to 30 seconds. Any longer than that then start over.

Election of Officers in 2026

Next year is an election year.

Over the winter, all members need to give some thought to running for an office next year.

FYI, several current officers are not running for re-election!!!

That said, this is your opportunity to step up, be an active member, and assist with leading the club in the future.

At election time we need to have multiple candidate choices for each office and not just one default name — or, no name at all in some cases; that's not really a choice.

Zero or one candidate for an individual office does not speak well for our memberships commitment to the idea of what a club is. It basically implies that we are only here to do the absolute minimum — if even that much.

At the last club election we had <u>no one run for one of the offices</u> and <u>two of the offices had last minute</u> <u>candidate name submissions</u> — as in, if no one else cares to run I guess I'll, reluctantly, give it a go.

Passive membership doesn't do much for club progress.

Next spring, consider submitting your name as a candidate for one of the officer positions.

Basic Election Info for Our Newer Members

There are six (6) elected officers: president, vice president, secretary, treasurer, and one campground director for each campground.

Officers serve a 3 year term.

You must be a member for one full year before you can run for an office.

Basic officer duties are outlined in the club by-laws. (By-laws were provided in your information packet when you joined. They are also available on the club website at: ttcm.org)

Pertinent Election Info for Seasoned Members (and New Members)

The election process was changed at the last by-laws update.

You would be well advised to read and familiarize yourself with the election voting procedure changes.

If you refuse to know the updated process – because you can't be bothered to read the by-laws – don't complain when you don't get to vote!!!
